





Best suited to larger arenas which are subjected to heavier footfall, the Premier Track consists of two key elements. The surface itself is a unique blend of high-grade silica sand mixed with polypropylene synthetic stabilising fibres, providing an excellent level of bounce, shock absorption and energy return to keep horses healthy and prevent lower-limb injuries. Underneath the surface, an Ebb & Flow drainage system is installed, which automatically maintains the level of surface moisture, eliminating the need for above-ground watering systems.

With constant moisture control afforded by the underground system, the surface is unlikely to become dusty, and the elasticity, created through the capillary action of the sand, will be maintained more accurately than would be achieved with manual watering.

The Ebb & Flow system is popular with large equestrian facilities, such as the new British Showjumping National Training Centre and the David Broome Event Centre, who have praised it for the ease of maintenance it provides and the consistent surface quality.

## Stage 1

Our teams will break ground at the site, removing the turf before installing the drainage system

#### Stage 2

The fencing will then be concreted into the ground and the surface membrane will be installed over the drainage system





## Stage 3

Once everything is perfectly level, your new surface is installed. Happy riding!

There are three options for the base of your arena...

#### 1. The traditional stone base

The traditional base is the most widely-used option. Consisting of a fully perforated drainage pipe system, a stone blanket with separation membranes is then laid on top before the riding surface is installed.

## 2. Stone and grid system

The stone and grid system is mainly used in the construction of temporary arenas, such as for competition sites or for those waiting on planning permissions to be passed. The stone and grid system can also be used over a stone drainage blanket for turnouts and lunge pens to replace the use of a membrane. Being more robust in nature, the stone and grid system won't be damaged by digging in a turnout.

## 3. Ebb & Flow system

The Ebb & Flow system is a specialised under-surface watering system which eliminates the need for above-ground watering, making surface maintenance more straightforward.
